WHSB Boys Parents' Association '100 Club' Rules

1. The club shall be known as WHSB Parents' Association '100 Club'.
2. The purpose of the WHSB Parents' Association '100 Club' is to raise funds to support the School.
3. The '100 Club' will be run under the supervision of the WHSB Parents' Association who also administer the '100 Club'.
4. Membership of the '100 Club' is open to anyone over the age of 18 who has an association (either past or present) with the School.
5. As there is no start or finish date, new membership will commence on receipt of confirmation of the first monthly payment.
6. Members must be aged 18 and over and complete an application form. Members may have and are encouraged to apply for one or more shares (numbers).
7. The '100 Club' shall not be restricted to 100 members.
8. Entry will be by subscription of £5 per month by standing order paid on the 20th of each month.
9. The draw will be monthly and drawn in arrears at the appropriate Parents' Association Meeting. (August will be drawn at the first available date in the new academic year).
10. Winners will be contacted in writing following the draw.
11. The prize money will be 45% of the membership fee taken that month. The remaining 55% goes to the School to help fund equipment and resources for pupils.
12. Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them. Any change of address or bank details should be notified in writing to WHSB Parents' Association 100 Club via the School Office.
13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the '100 Club' if their renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of two months.
14. The WHSB Parents' Association Committee shall have absolute discretion to reduce the amount payable in prizes should membership drop to an unacceptable level. The Parents' Association Committee may amend or vary these Rules at any time and in any way in which they see fit, so long as any such amendment or variation is in the best interests of the '100 Club'. Any amendments will be notified to members in writing.

The Committee of the Parents' Association
